California tenant rights laws cover a myriad of issues from before

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you even sign a lease to after you've moved out. For example, California law prohibits landlords from discriminating against rental applicants based on race, religion, sexual orientation, disability, and other protected characteristics.

California Tenant Rights Laws - FindLaw

In California, a landlord may file for eviction if: The tenant does not pay rent on time. The tenant breaks the rules of the lease and is unwilling to right them. The tenant or guest of the tenant causes damage that leads to loss in property value. The tenant is a repeated nuisance to neighbors or other tenants.

What You Need to Know About Tenant Rights in California

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California tenants are legally entitled to rental property that meets basic structural, health, and safety standards and is in good repair. If a landlord fails to take care of important

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maintenance (such as a leaky roof or a broken heater), tenants may have the legal rights to:

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Tenant Rights to Withhold Rent in California Tenants may withhold rent, move out without notice, sue the landlord, call state or local health inspectors, or exercise the right to “repair and deduct” if a landlord fails to take care of important repairs, such as a broken heater.

A security deposit is any money a landlord takes from a tenant other than the advance payment of rent. The security deposit serves to protect the landlord if the tenant breaks or violates the terms of the lease or rental agreement.

California's 2020 Tenant Protection Act: AB 1482

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Answer: In California, 30-days written notice is required to terminate a month-to-month tenancy and can be served by either party at any time during the tenancy. If the occupants have been in possession for one year or longer, the landlord must serve a 60-day notice.
